SUBJECT: INTRODUCING THE REVISED STARS "LEARNING GUIDE FOR THE CAREGIVER WHO KNOWS THE CHILD" TRAINING MANUAL AND ASSESSMENT TOOL

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform staff that the STARS "Learning Guide for the Caregiver Who Knows the Child" training manual and Family Assessment Tool have been revised to better meet the needs of Caregivers. Many of the revisions to the "Learning Guide for the Caregiver Who Knows the Child" were the result of a statewide survey completed by kinship caregivers regarding their experiences with this learning and assessment process. Major revisions include the following:

- Updated information of Permanency Goals;
- A more in-depth explanation of Concurrent Planning to assist in a better understanding by the caregiver;
- Information was added regarding the "Ready, Set, Fly" program;
- Information was enhanced to assist Kinship Caregivers in identifying and dealing the "Risks in the Community";
- Emphasis on the importance of stress management by the caregiver;
- The addition of the "Rights and Responsibilities of Children in Foster Care";
- Additional information on healthcare and self-care of the caregiver;
- Updated resources and support services;
- Information on the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA); and
- The addition of a "Training Assessment" form.

This guide and assessment tool will be sent to each Circuit and Regional Office.
