The purpose of this E-mail memorandum is to announce that Faith Foundation Children's Home has added an operating site at Rt. 1 Box 85B, Arcadia, MO 63621. The agency has also renamed the operating sites to clarify the physical location of each one. Each site will be named Faith Foundation Children's Home with an additional physical site distinct name. The initial site will be referred to as Faith Foundation Children's Home-Faith. The site in the town of Fredericktown will be named Faith Foundation Children's Home-Integrity. The new site in the

Arcadia area will be called Faith Foundation Children's Home-Peaceful Valley. It is the former Shenandoah Boys Ranch which was on voluntary intake suspension (see E-mail CD08-59), voluntarily closed and is now a Faith Foundation Children's Home operating site. This new Faith Foundation Children's Home operating site is licensed for basic core and residential treatment for thirteen (13) males, ages eight (8) to twenty-one (21) years. Faith Foundation Children's Home is contracted with the Children's Division for emergency shelter, moderate needs (level II), and severe needs (level III) residential treatment, family focus residential treatment, and transitional living apartments.
