## DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this memorandum is to introduce the screening protocol for the medical response to child sexual abuse. The SAFE-CARE Advisory Council developed this protocol to ensure compliance with Missouri Revised Statute Section 334.950.4 which requires the SAFE-CARE network to formulate recommendations concerning medically based screening processes and forensic evidence collection for children who may be in need of an emergency examination following an alleged sexual assault. Such recommendations shall be provided to the SAFE-CARE providers, child advocacy centers, hospitals and licensed practitioners that provide emergency examinations for children suspected of being victims of abuse.

While this protocol was developed specifically to guide professionals responsible for conducting medical examinations of children, all Children's Division staff involved in child sexual abuse investigations should be familiar with the protocol.
