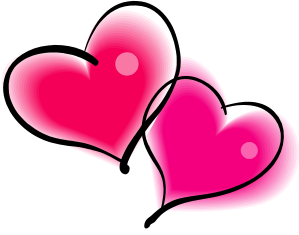

This event allows the Children's Division, the Phelps County Community Partnership, the InterFraternity Council, and Pan-Hellenic Council of the Missouri University of Science and Technology to offer an opportunity for prospective adoptive families and children to meet and interact with each other in a fun and relaxed environment. The Linking Hearts event has been successful over the years in creating forever families for waiting children and increasing awareness of the need for adoptive homes for children from foster care.

This year's event will be held on Friday, September 16, 2016. The event will be held at the Lion's Club Park in Rolla, Missouri. Registration for children will begin at 1:00 p.m. at The Centre. Activities will include games, swimming, volleyball, basketball and crafts. 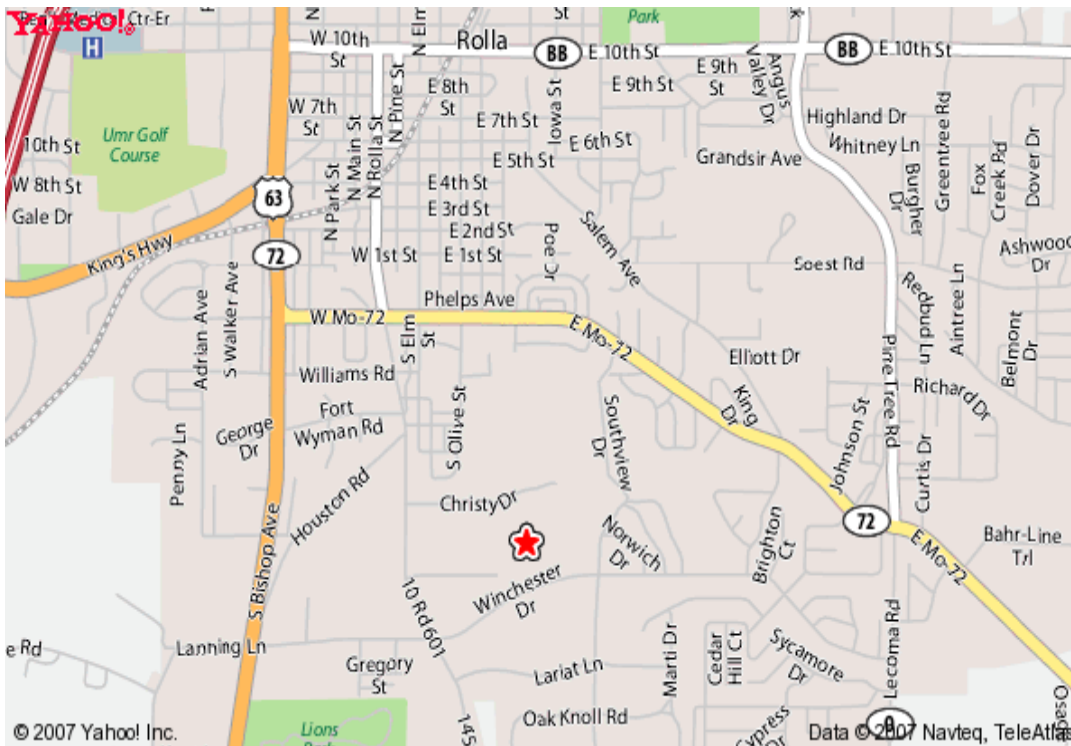
Directions to The Centre

From I-44 (east or west): Take exit 186 and head south. Turn left onto 10th street-will be a stop light. You will pass by Rolla High School on your right. Just after that, there is a stop light, turn left onto Holloway. The Centre is on the right.

From South 63: Head north through town. Turn right onto 10th street-will be a stop light. You will pass by Rolla High School on your right. Just after that, there is a stop light, turn left onto Holloway. The Centre is on the right.
