FOOD STAMP MASTER DEATH MATCH - FOLLOW-UP LISTING SUPERVISOR/CASEWORKER COPIES

PURPOSE: The follow-up listing includes death matches received through IIVE or the quarterly death match over 30 days old for which no action has been taken to remove a matched individual from a suspended, active or pending assistance case. The matched individual will appear on the follow-up listing until appropriate action has been taken to remove the individual from a food stamp case. Both the supervisor and caseworker listing are the same.

DISPOSITION: The listing is sorted by caseload. Ensure the deceased individual has been removed from all active assistance cases. Retention of the listings are at the discretion of the county. Report FIFDY305-02 is the supervisor copy. Report FIFDY305-03 is the caseworker copy.

<u>DESCRIPTION:</u> The listings are generated monthly after the quarterly death match is produced. The listings also include Third Party Queries for which a death match occurred and the individual is still active on a case.

CASE IDENTIFICATION

<u>COUNTY:</u> The county for the case in which the matched individual is receiving or applying for food stamp benefits is shown.

<u>LOAD:</u> The load number entered into FSU5 for the case in which the matched individual is receiving or applying for food stamp benefits is shown.

<u>SUPERVISOR NUMBER/NAME:</u> The number and name of the IM Supervisor as shown in field 42 of FSU5 is shown.

<u>WORKER NUMBER/NAME:</u> The worker number/name of the IM worker as shown in field 40 of FSU5 is shown.

<u>CASE DCN AND NAME:</u> The case DCN and case name is shown for the food stamp case in which the matched individual is receiving benefits.

INDIVIDUAL DCN:
The DCN of the individual matched to the SSMDI is shown.

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<u>INDIVIDUAL NAME:</u> The individual's name as reported to the Social Security Administration is shown.

<u>SSN:</u> The social security number of the individual matched to the SSMDI is shown.

<u>SEX:</u> The sex of the matched individual as reported to the Social Security Administration is listed.

<u>DATE OF BIRTH (DOB):</u> The matched individual's date of birth as reported to the Social Security Administration is shown.

<u>DEATH DATE:</u> The date of death for the matched individual is shown. No date of death in this field indicates a social security number, date of birth or surname does not match Social Security records. No death match was completed.

<u>MATCH DATE:</u> The date shown is the date the death match was generated by the Social Security Administration.

TYPE: The type of match is listed. The type can either be IV (IIVE) Third Party Query or QM (Quarterly Death Match).

ADDITIONAL MESSAGES

The following messages may appear at the bottom of this report:

*INDICATES DECEASED INDIVIDUAL IS STILL ACTIVE ON FS CASE: This message informs the worker and supervisor the individual is still active and action must be taken to remove the individual or close the individual's food stamp case. If it is determined the individual is NOT deceased, follow instructions outlined in FIFDY305-01 for resolution.

NOTE: NO DEATH DATE INDICATES A DISCREPANCY IN SSN, DATE OF BIRTH OR SURNAME. This message informs the worker and supervisor a discrepancy has occurred with the individual's SSN, date of birth or surname. Follow instructions outlined in FIFDY305-01 for resolution.
