Custodial Parent

70% Funds Criteria

- Currently receiving TANF and has received for 30+ months
- Has one or more of the "characteristics associated with, or predictive of long-term welfare dependency, such as:

Check all that apply:

- High School Dropout
- Pregnant teen or teen parent
- Poor work history (not worked at least 13 consecutive weeks in past 12 months in full-time unsubsidized employment
- Previous original history
- # of children under age 6
- Other (can be locally determined)

Noncustodial Parent

70% Funds Criteria

- Unemployed, underemployed, or having difficulty paying child support obligations and
- Minor children are eligible for, or receiving TANF benefits, received TANF during the preceding year, or are eligible for, or receiving assistance under the Food Stamp program, the Supplemental Security Income program, Medicaid, or the Children's Health Insurance program and
- They enter into a personal responsibility contract under which they commit to cooperating in establishing paternity and paying child support and participating in services to increase their employment and earnings, and to support their children.

Other Eligible Participants

30% Funds Criteria

- Youth aged 18 to 25 who have "aged out" of foster care
- Custodial parents with incomes below the poverty line
