## Case ID:

A Temporary Restraining Order has been issued in the court case of White Vs Martin (Case No. 02-4154-CV-C-NKL). The order directs the Division of Family Services to provide Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA) to families with earned income who lost Medical Assistance for Families (MAF) eligibility on July 1, 2002 due to the lower income limit established by HB 1111, if the family received MAF for three of the past six months.

The TMA program provides MC+ healthcare coverage for the family for six months following MAF ineligibility, and if other requirements are met, the family may be eligible for an additional six months. In order to qualify for this healthcare coverage you must meet the following conditions:

- Have received MAF healthcare coverage for at least three of the last six months prior to July 1, 2002 and
- Have countable earned income.

Our files indicate you did not meet the requirements necessary to qualify for TMA. If you think our records are incorrect, you will need to contact your MC+ Service Representative to inquire about eligibility for TMA.

There has been no change in your child(ren)'s healthcare coverage.
