Effective February 1, 2003, your General Relief grant is being reduced to \$9.00.

If you request a hearing on or before January 27, 2003, your benefits will continue pending the results of the hearing. If you request a hearing on or before January 27, 2003, it will be held January ____, 2003, at 8:00 A.M. at your local Division of Family Services office. At the hearing, you may present your information yourself or you may be represented by your own attorney or by other persons who know your situation. If you do not have an attorney, or cannot afford one, you may be able to get help from Legal Aid or Legal Services in your area. You have the right to bring witnesses to testify at the hearing and to question witnesses who appear at the request of the Division of Family Services.
