at Low or No Cost to Parents**

Some of the covered benefits include:

- ♀ Doctor visits, including well-child checks, shots and sports physicals
- ⊕ Hospital and emergency room care
- ♀ Mental health care
- ⊕ Dental and vision care
- ♀ Prescriptions, lab tests and x-rays
- ⊕ Speech and physical therapy

Children may be eligible for MC+ for Kids if they are under age 19, uninsured for six months or more\* and meet family income guidelines.

\*There are some exceptions. For example, if a child loses health insurance when a parent loses a job through a layoff or closing, there is no six-month waiting period. Additional programs, with different income and eligibility guidelines, are available for low-income children, their parents and pregnant women through other MC+ health care programs.
