

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

On or after September 1, 2005, you either applied for the MC+ Program and were rejected or your case was closed as a result of having access to affordable health insurance. At that time, the affordability standard for health coverage was \$342 per month. This meant that you had insurance available to you for your children that cost less than \$342 per month. As a result, your children were not eligible for the MC+ Program.

Effective July 1, 2006, the affordability standards are changing; they will be based on your household's income. Please see the chart on the backside of this notice for the revised standards. If you are interested in reapplying for MC+ under the new affordability standards listed or if you have questions, please contact your local Family Support Division office.
