## IMPORTANT NOTICE

On or after July 1, 2006, your children's healthcare coverage was closed or denied because you had access to affordable health insurance. At that time families with income between 150% and 300% of the FPL with access to insurance were required to meet the following affordability guidelines:

- Above 150% up to and including 185% of the FPL = \$209/month
- Above 185% up to and including 225% of the FPL = \$255/month
- Above 225% up to and including 300% of the FPL = \$375/month

If insurance was available for the children below these levels, the child(ren) were not eligible for the MC+ healthcare coverage due to access to affordable health insurance.

Effective September 1, 2007, the affordability standards are changing. Families with income between 150% and 300% of the FPL with access to insurance must meet the following new affordability guidelines:

- 151%-185% of the FPL = \$64/month
- 186%-225% of the FPL = \$106/month
- 226%-300% of the FPL = \$161/month

The chart on the back of this notice shows the new standards. If you are interested in obtaining MC+ healthcare coverage, please contact your local Family Support Division office to apply or ask questions if your children are currently uninsured and you do not have access to insurance below the new amounts.
