*Non-core hours can be worked in any activity (including other "core" activities); however, the maximum amount of Community Service and AWEP/CWEP cannot be exceeded due to FLSA requirements.

**Federally funded childcare is the Children's Division (CD) Child Care Program. If the parents do not receive this childcare for whatever reason, they have a reduced amount of required hours. These hours can be achieved in any combination to meet the total hours required for the 2-parents combined. (i.e. Parent 1 could work 20 core hours and Parent 2 could work 10 core and 5 non-core hours.) Thorough case notes are required when this is done.

***These hours can be achieved in any combination to meet the total hours required for the 2-parents combined. (i.e. Parent 1 could work 40 core hours and Parent 2 could work 10 core and 5 non-core hours.) Thorough case notes are required when this is done.
