

Temporary Assistance Work Requirements on COMPACT Screen User Guide

The below chart contains a list of codes with the description and the impact to the client:

- Exempt - Not required to participate in MWA
- Excluded - Temporarily not required to participate with MWA work activities
- Hardship extension – Past lifetime limit
- Lifetime limit Counts - Months received count toward 45 month limit
