LICENSED RESOURCE PROVIDERS ANNUAL IN-SERVICE TRAINING SUBJECT:

REQUIREMENT FOR 2021

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform resource licensing workers that all licensed resource providers are required to complete a one (1) hour annual in-service training on Psychotropic Medications. This memorandum introduces the resource providers annual in-service training entitled "Healthy Sleep Habits."

The focus of this training is to improve sleep education and child sleep health as one pathway to reduce or eliminate the need for psychotropic medications for sleep or daytime mood/behavior. This training provides information on the science of sleep, behavioral strategies for healthy sleep, medications for pediatric sleep concerns, and a quiz. Successful completion of training will require the resource provider to pass the guiz with a score of 80% or more.

Resource providers can locate the training on the Resources for Professionals & Stakeholders or the Lam a Foster Parent web page. When the training is complete, the resource provider will be required to obtain a screen shot of the guiz completion score, create an e-mail that includes their name, date and A170 code number and send the e-mail to the resource licensing worker.

Resource providers who do not have access to the online training can request a paper copy from their resource licensing worker. The resource-licensing worker will mail the paper version of the training to the resource provider. The resource provider will review the training, complete the quiz, place their name and a date on the quiz and mail the guiz to the resource licensing worker who will determine the score. The resource licensing worker will provide the results to the resource provider and provide credit for successful completion of the course or inform the resource provider that completion of the training was not successful and they will need to review the training and resubmit a quiz.

This training must be completed through Internet Explorer and completed by Monday November 1, 2021.
