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Excessive Dosage Guideline

The Excessive Dosage Guidelines chart for psychotropic medications is reviewed and updated annually. The purpose of this Practice Alert is to inform Children's Division and contracted staff members that the Excessive Dosage Guidelines have been revised and are located on the following websites:

As a reminder, staff must review the Excessive Dosage Guidelines PRIOR to providing consent for psychotropic medication, in order to determine if a mandatory review is required BEFORE they can make an informed decision about consenting to a medication.
